CLUB BUSINESS

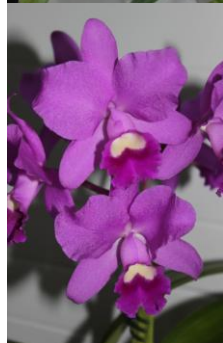
Congratulations to Meg Kerr for accepting the nomination for President 2015-16.
